§101. Purpose.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Sewickley are hereby authorized to undertake and expend funds for Social Service Programs and Community Development Programs for the residents of the Township as the Board of Supervisors from time to time and in their discretion deem the same to be necessary and in the best interests of the Township.

§102. Use of Terms.

The terms "Social Service Programs" and "Community Development Programs" when used in this Ordinance shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Act of December 10, 1974, P.L. 865, No. 292, as amended by the Act of December 3, 1978, P.L. 478, No. 141.

§103. Authorization.

In undertaking the above activities and programs, the Board of Supervisors are authorized, in expending township and other funds received for such purposes, to make appropriations to nonprofit corporations organized for community development purposes.

§104. Authority.

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Authority granted to the Township under the Act of December 10, 1974, P.L. 865, No. 292, as amended by the Act of December 3, 1975, P.L. 478, No. 141, and the Township of Sewickley hereby adopts and makes part of this Ordinance, those powers and procedures granted to municipalities in the above referenced Acts.
